EX-KAISER DOES NOT LACK FOR CASH

Amherst, July 8.—The former German Emperor has been discussing his financial problems for more than a week with Dr. J. Krieger, who has been charged with the disposal of the funds in Germany since the Hohenzollern abdication.

Dr. Krieger, one of the former German financiers of the German Empire, has been here in conference with Herr Hohenzollern, and the latter was not engaged in actual business but to discuss the emperor's financial situation.

The former Emperor is not short of money as is supposed. A considerable amount of money has been put at his disposal. It was added to appreciable while hostilities were in progress. During the past several weeks preceding the abdication, Wilhelm and his followers transferred further large sums in ready cash.

Dr. Wilhelm is troubled as to the fate of his estates. He possesses no fewer than fifty-five estates, hunting boxes and country seats scattered over the Empire. The revenues of these estates are in the hands of the new government, which hitherto has paid from the proceeds of the Hohenzollerns' titles, forwarded to Berlin for settlement and the upkeep of his estates. Besides paying the wages of the gardener and domestics of the Hohenzollerns, he has to cover his own expenses while working out of the Hohenzollerns' estates.

U. S. WILL SELL SUGAR AT COST

Washington, July 9.—Sale of 25,000 tons of surplus sugar, now held by the War Department, has been authorized. It was announced Tuesday, at a bulletin press to be fixed by the United States sugar equalization board to cover the cost to the government.

The only condition of sale will be that the price of the sugar will be fixed by the War Department and the price in the east of the Mississippi will be made to include the purchase in that section.
