## GIVES THE LOBSTER LAW AS HE SEES IT

Fishermen in this vicinity, especially along the Maine coast, who interpret the law regarding lobsters written by Judge Scott Wilson of Portland, in the York County court case of *Wilson vs. Charlet*, Judge Wilson rules in favor of the state and his receipt will do nothing to aid in the many arguments coming up daily regarding the law. The receipt points out that prior to 1901 a penalty was imposed in short lobster case for catching lobsters in possession before they were sold. Under the revised statute however, the basis of the offense of buying, selling, taking away or exposing for sale or having in possession is the fact that the lobsters are less than lawful length whatever the condition in which they may be found. The intention of the law is to protect whether dead or alive, cooled or uncooked. In a complaint for buying, selling, taking away or exposing for sale, it is not necessary to prove that the lobsters were sold, cooled, or uncooked.
